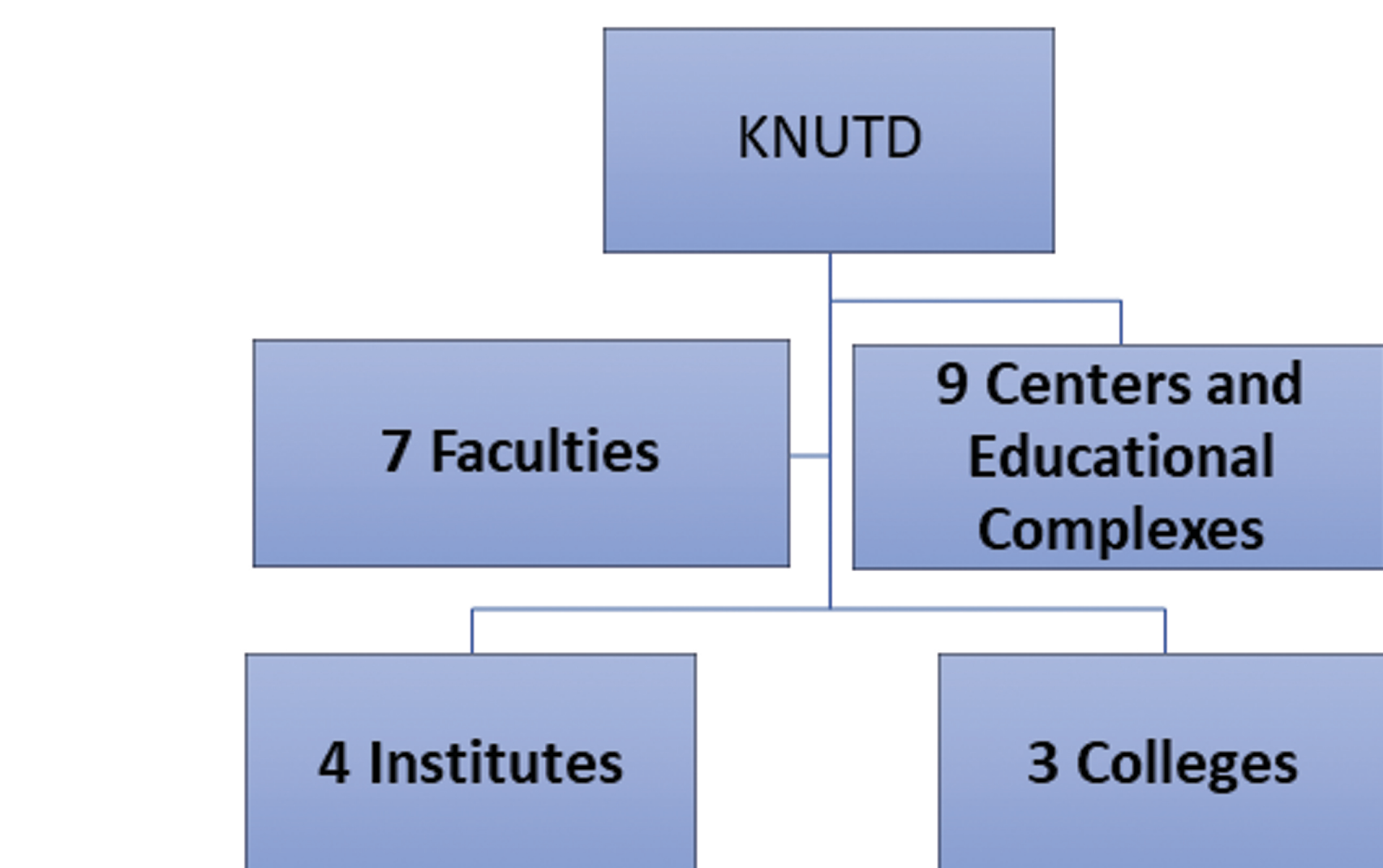
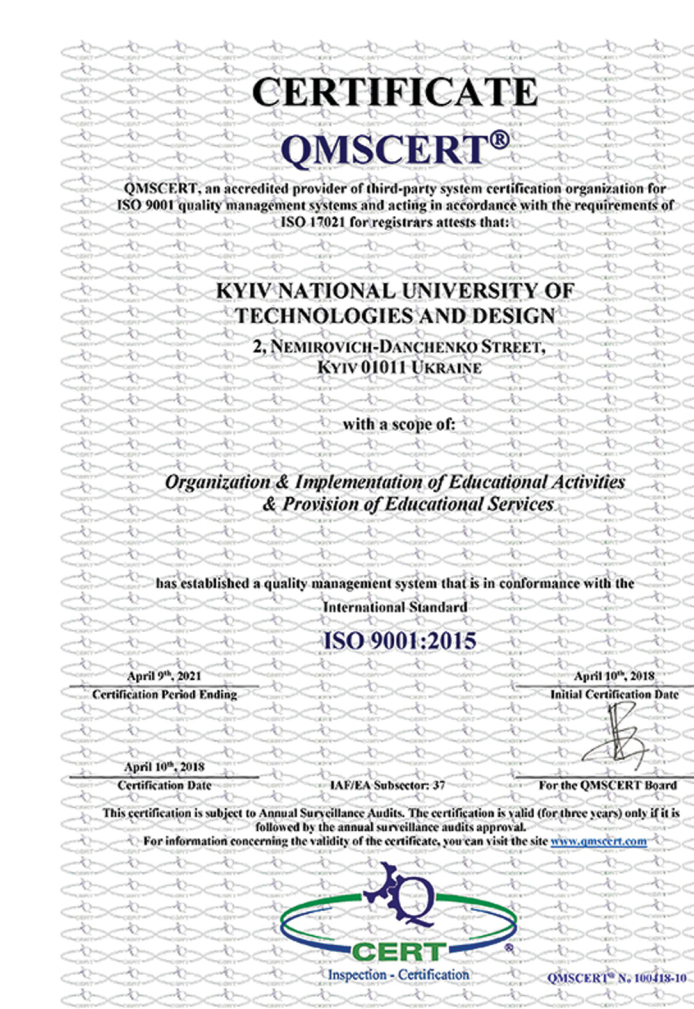
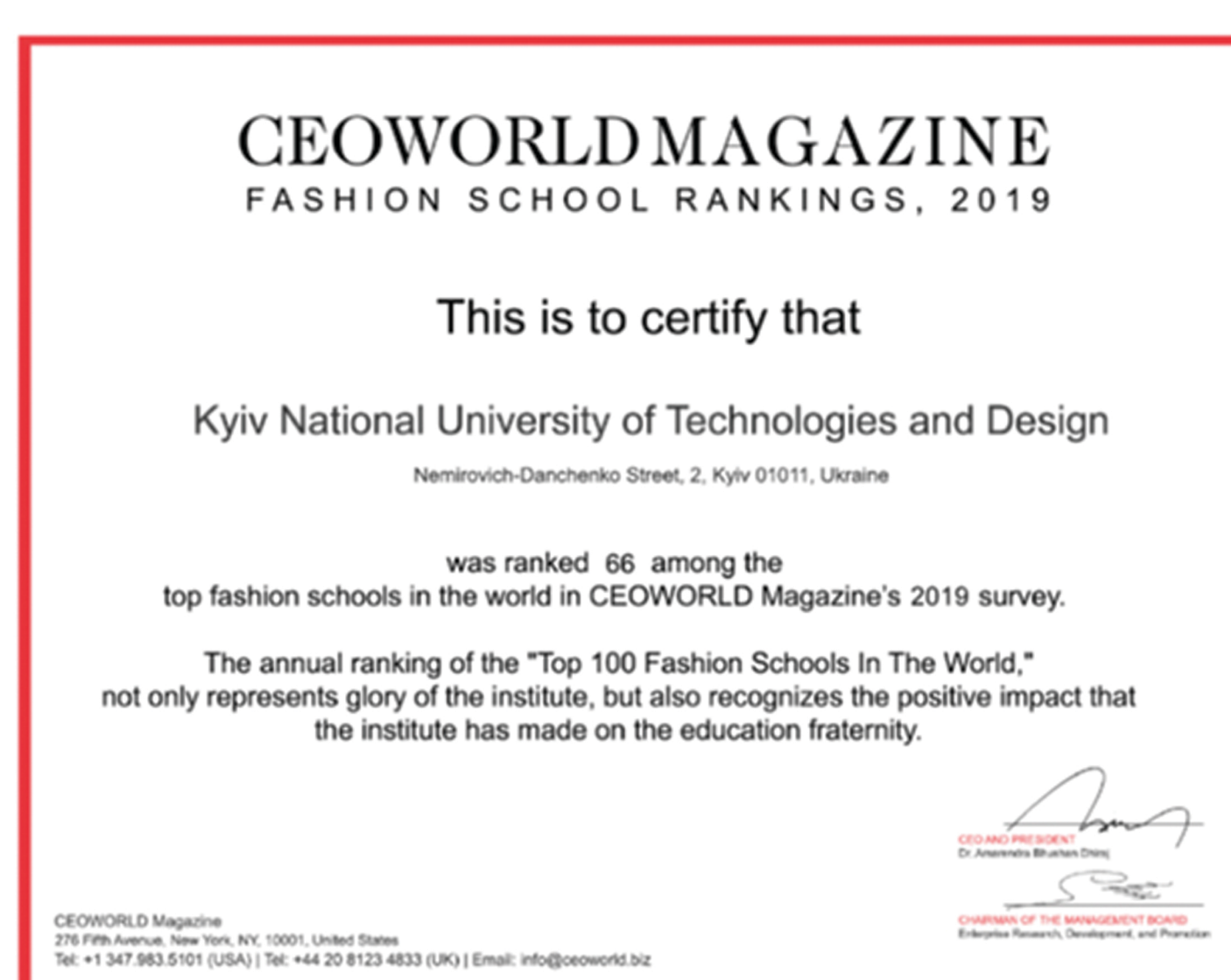


April 17, 1930 - was founded on as the Institute of Leather Industry with 485 students.

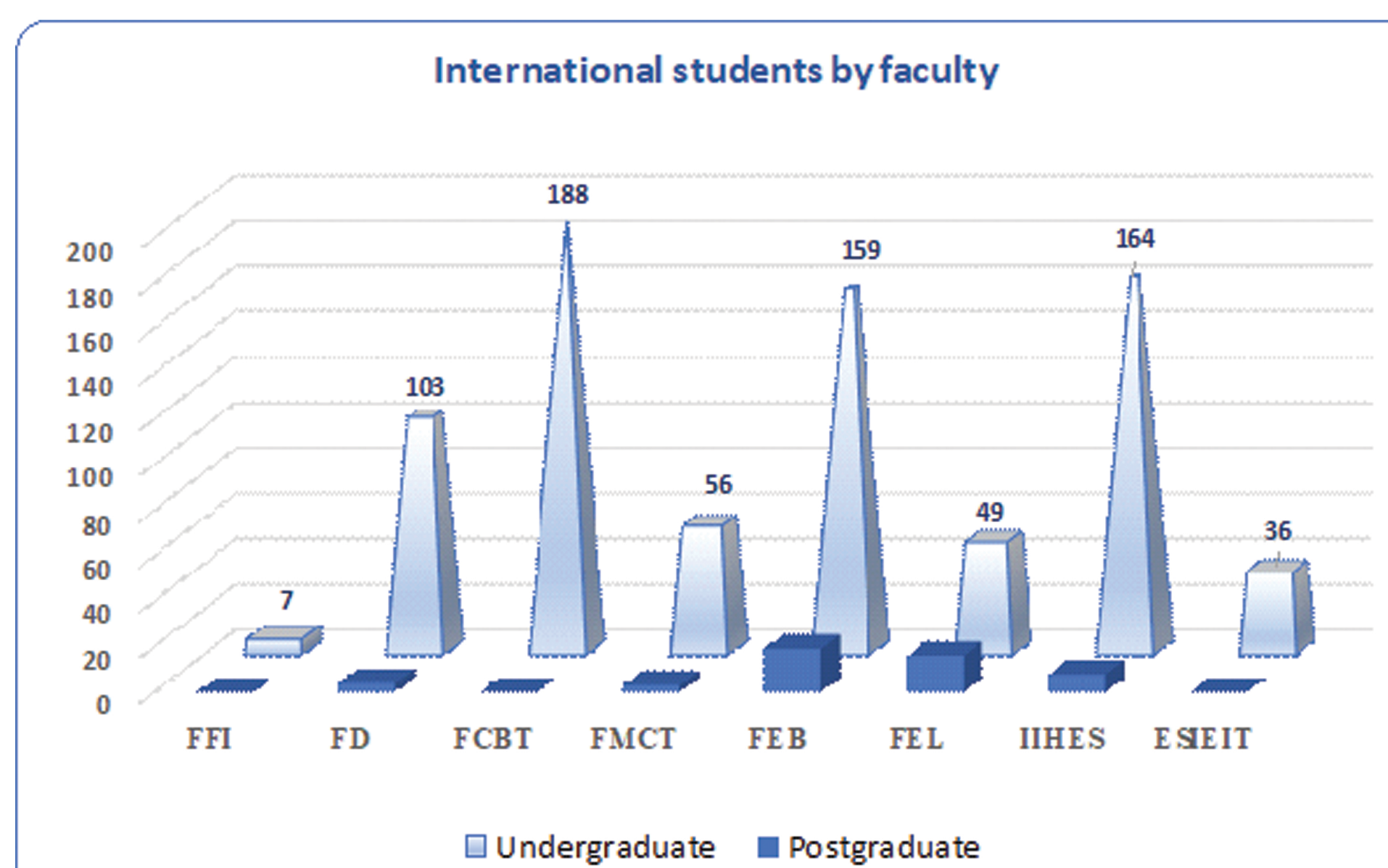
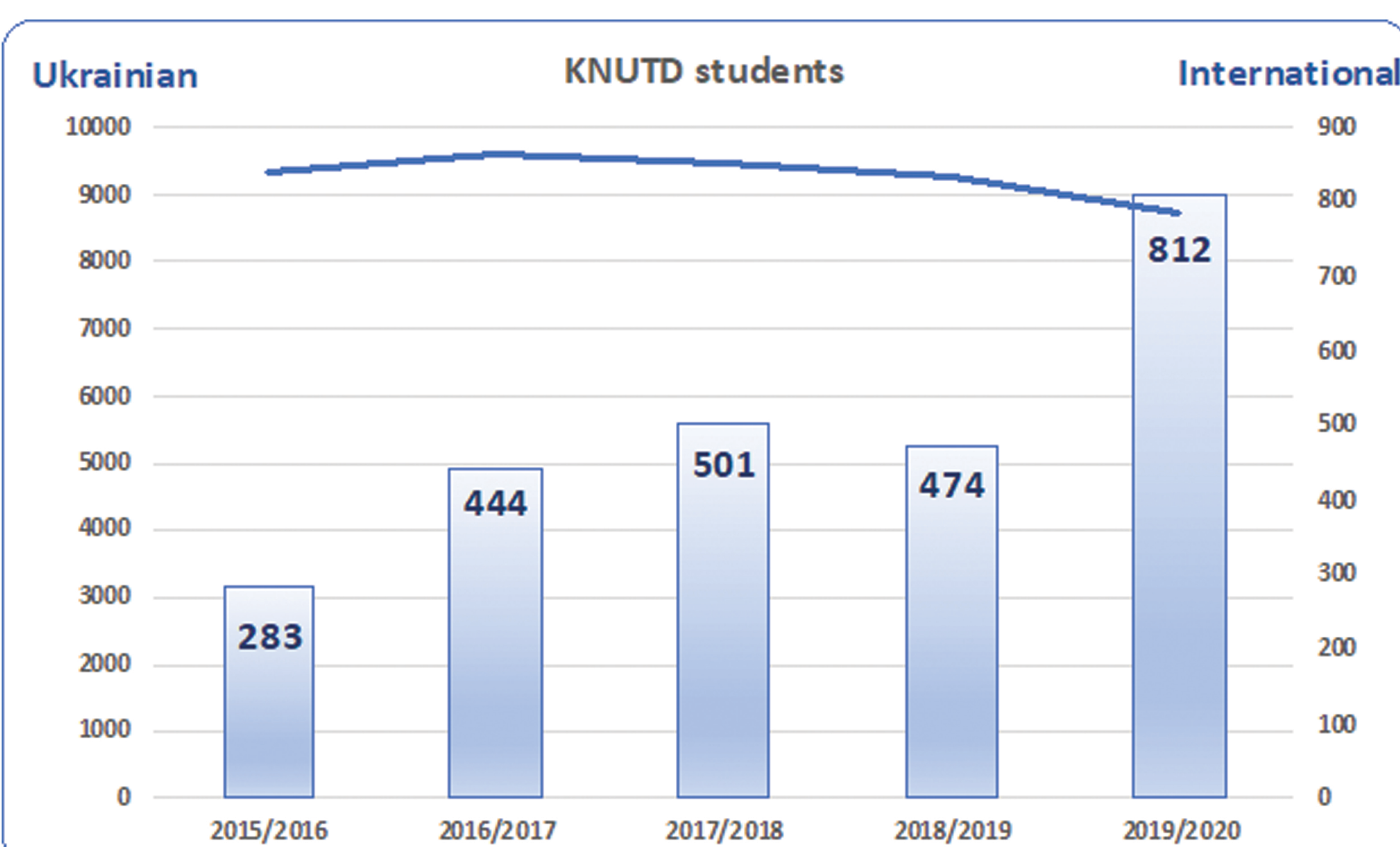
RECOGNITIONS

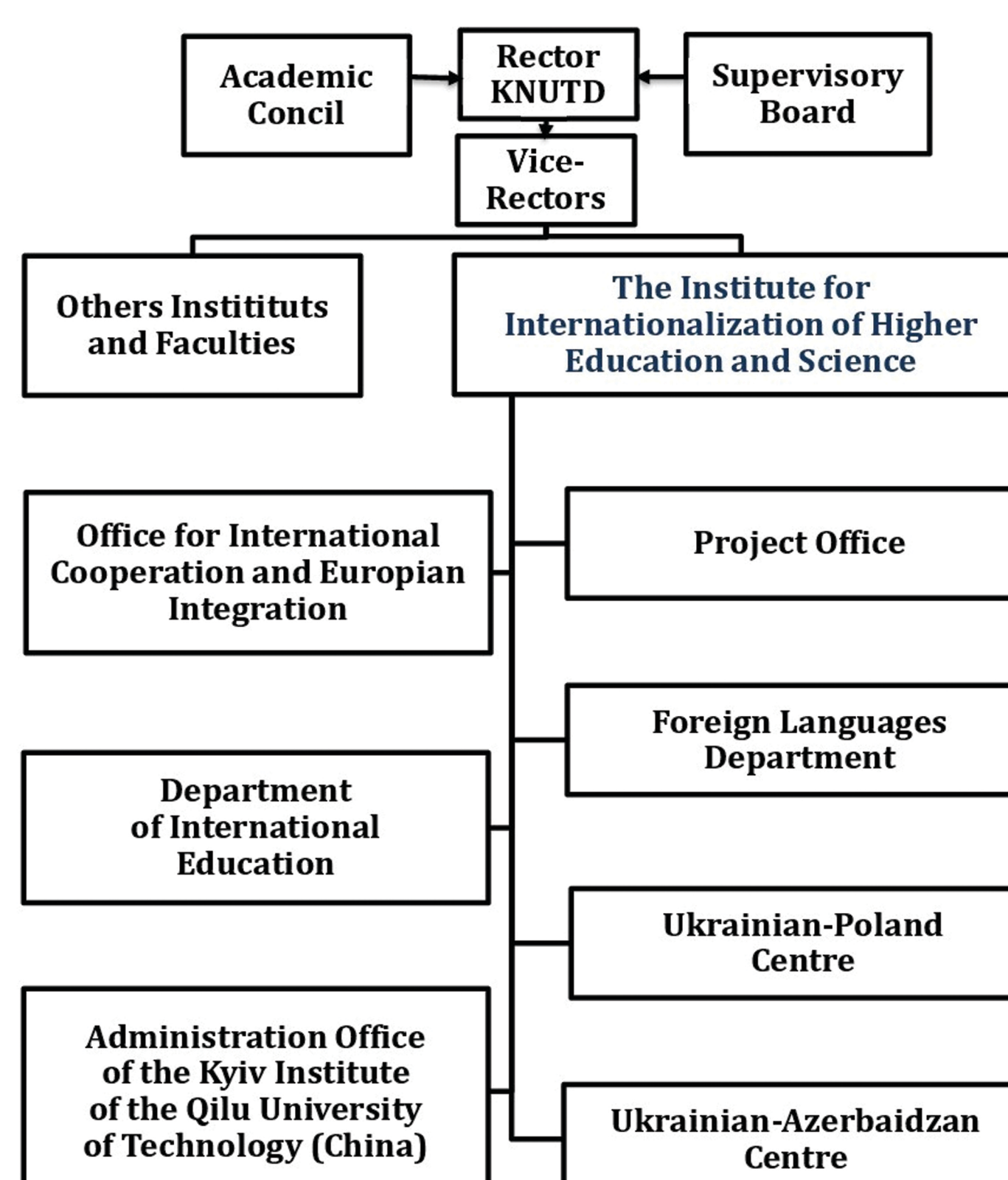
Program for 2019-2023
